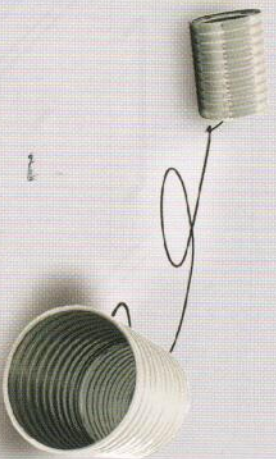


# Our Mission....

## THE IMPORTANCE OF GETTING A

### DIGALERT TICKET BEFORE YOU DIG:

Beneath the surface of the ground, hidden from view, are gas lines, water lines, cable lines and other utilities. If you don't know exactly where they are, your digging could cause disruption to services, harm to the general public, injuries, even an explosion.

By contacting DigAlert, you begin the process of notifying our members who own underground utilities and have requested notification within the area of your planned excavation.

The members' representatives then have 2 full working days in which to respond to your jobsite to mark the lines they own and maintain so you can avoid damaging them during your digging.

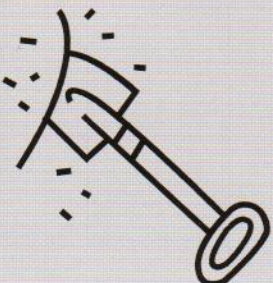
Prior to contacting DigAlert, mark off the area you plan to dig with water-soluble or chalk-based white paint, stakes or flags.

Call up to 14 days but at least 2 full working days before digging.



## YOU PROVIDE:

- Contact Phone Number
- Information on company doing the work
- Foreman/Person in charge phone #
- Dig area pre-marked in white
- County and City
- Job address or location description
- Method of digging (boring, explosives, vacuum)
- Type of Work
- For whom the work is being done
- Permit number
- Marking instructions
- Work date and time



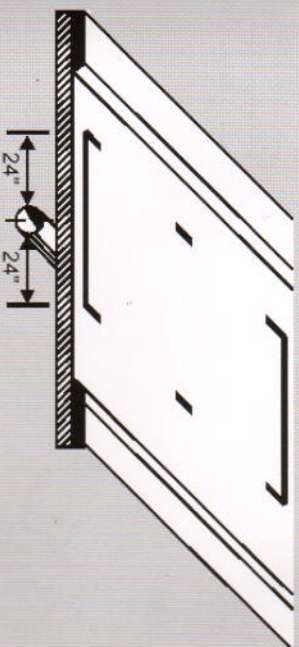
## YOU RECEIVE:

- List of members being notified
- DigAlert ticket number
- Expiration Date
- Update online or by phone

## JOBBSITE 123's:



- Confirm Utility Response/Advise of failure to respond
- Hand Expose lines to point of no conflict (24" on either side of the underground facility)
- Respect Marks
- Contact DigAlert for remarks from owners of underground lines if marks not reasonably visible.
